

YOUTH LISTEN TO GOD'S CALL

Pinto Mennonite's 4th – 8th grade Sunday school class was so inspired by a recent lesson titled "Courage to Follow God's Call" that they decided to take action. Class members Aaron Monnett, Caleb Livengood and Mary Twigg organized a toy drive that will benefit local area children this Christmas.

The idea came to them during a study in the book of Exodus when Moses is called to speak to the Israelites. Moses tries to convince God he is not the right man for the job; *no one will listen to him, he can't speak in public, someone else would do a better job.* Moses was afraid. He saw too many obstacles in his path to believe he would be effective in what God was calling him to do.

A modern example was of a young man who felt moved to help feed children in Africa. He was only 9 years old so what could he do? He liked to play basketball, so he made a plan to have sponsors donate money for every basket that he could shoot. He raised enough money to not only feed some children but many families. The next year others joined in and a clinic was built in Africa that will save an entire generation.

On hearing this, Sunday School member Aaron immediately said, "I like to play basketball. Why can't we do something like that?" His enthusiasm quickly spread to other class members Caleb and Mary. Within minutes the three of them were organizing the event and voting on what to do with the money they were going to raise. It would have been so easy to let the moment pass as "a nice thought" or "something we should do sometime".

I have to admit, when I prepared the lesson for that day, it never occurred to me that God would actually call us (me) into action so soon. I was thinking, "*Why me? I don't even like sports. Someone else would be better suited for this type of activity, this really isn't a good time for me.*" Sound familiar?

For a while I just listened as the kids talked and planned for that and future events they were so confident would come. They were excited. Really excited. Then it hit me, they were listening. Not only did they hear the lesson God
